## Updated IPC Anti-Doping Code and International Level Athlete (ILA) Name List

Dear Members,

The year 2015 saw the implementation of the new IPC Anti-Doping Code. After the first year, the IPC has decided to make small updates to the Code for clarity in articles and better formatting. This new version will be titled "IPC Anti-Doping Code — 12 November 2015". Enclosed you will find the list of changes that have been implemented from the 1 January 2015 version to the now current, 12 November 2015 version. Furthermore, we would like to bring to your attention the updated list of International Level Athletes (ILA) as defined by the IPC for IPC sports. The new list will come into effect on 1 January 2016. This is a name list published annually, per IPC sport in order to quickly identify which athletes must apply to the IPC if they require a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).
