We are fast approaching our World Archery 51<sup>st</sup> Congress and the World Archery Championships in Copenhagen. This information package provides you with the essential information in relation to the upcoming events, in particular our Congress.

### **Hotel for World Archery**

We are staying at the Bella Sky Hotel which is one of the most special buildings in Copenhagen. Address is Center Boulevard 5 Copenhagen and it is very close to the airport.

### **Executive Board Meeting**

The Executive Board meeting will take place on 23 July at 09:00 in the board room on the top floor of the Bella Sky Hotel. It should finish latest at 12:00 but the room will be available for other meetings in the afternoon.

The agenda and documents will be sent by Monday morning since we are still finalising some issues with some by-laws that seem to be a discussion between the committees.





### **Congress Location**

### **Congress meals**

### **Welcome Reception**

Following the close of the first day of Congress a welcome reception will be offered by World Archery at the Bella Sky hotel until 20:00. Transportation will be organised from the congress hotel to the Bella Sky and for the ones staying in the Scandic a bus will be organised at the end of the reception to return to the Scandic hotel for dinner. If you do not wish to attend the reception and you are staying at the Scandic please inform the staff during the congress session. Attendance is not mandatory.

### **Opening Reception**

On Saturday 25, there will be an opening reception at the Bella Sky which will act as the Opening Ceremony for the World Championships. Details will be provided during the Congress. Attendance is not mandatory but kindly requested

### **Attending World Championships**

Your congress accreditation will not provide you any field access. If you are part of your team delegation and providing you are within the maximum number of officials allowed on the field of play, you have to pick up your accreditation as official in the Bella Sky accreditation desk. If you wish to stay and watch as Executive Board Member please visit the accreditation desk in the Bella Sky hotel upon arrival and they will provide you an accreditation.

### **Workgroups during Congress**

Four different workgroups will be organised during the Congress. Themes are in line with the World Archery Plan and are as follows:

- Strategic Plans for Member Associations: This will be moderated by Lars Haue Pedersen from TSE and Vicente Martinez, chair of the Working group
- Communications, Social Media and Internet: This will be moderated by Chris Wells, World Archery Communications Manager
- National Event Strategy: This will be moderated by Juan-Carlos Holgado and will show examples of successful event strategies currently used by Member Associations
- Working with the Archery Trade Industry: This will be moderated by the Archery Trade Association Team who are attending Congress to see how they can work closer with the Member Associations. This will focus mainly on expansion of membership and working closer within the industry.

Executive Board members are not allocated to any group and are free to assist or not.

### **Official photograph**

We want to have an official photograph of all Executive Board Members since the ones we have are out of date and we all look much better than two years ago. Therefore,



please coordinate with Chris Wells to have your photograph taken during the two days of Congress. The Organiser will also make a picture of all congress delegates and you should have that picture taken as well but this is for a different purpose and this can only be done on Friday.

### **Tablets**

Tablets will be distributed for voting and will include the full Congress documentation. At the end of Congress you will receive a tablet for your own personal use. However during the Congress we recommend you use your tablet from last congress or your personal computer. We will provide power at the head table.

### **Documentation**

No printed documentation will be provided as part of World Archery's commitment to protecting the environment. All documents are available on the website several weeks prior and will also be available on the tablets.
